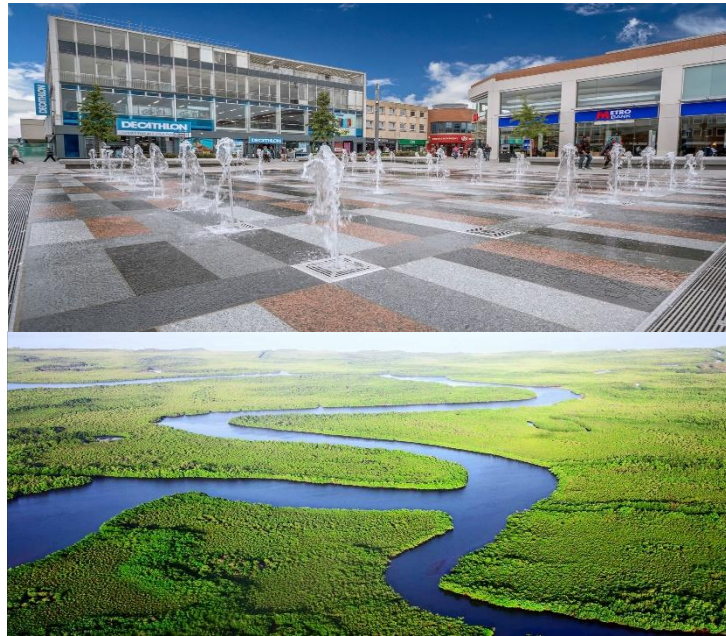
Science
