

Are you eligible for Free School Meals?
All children in EYFS, Year I and Year 2 are entitled to FSMs - this is known as Universal Infant Free School Meals.

In Year 3, however, this entitlement for most families will stop.

Free School Meals:

How do I know if I am still entitled?

In any part of the UK, from Year 3 onwards, your children could get free lunches (and sometimes milk, breakfast or fruit) at school if you are receiving one of these benefits:

- ✓ Income Support
- ✓ Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- ✓ Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- ✓ The guarantee element of Pension Credit
- ✓ Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- ✓ Working Tax Credit 'run-on' the payment someone may receive for a further four weeks after they stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- ✓ Universal Credit






