2 reader, I
will need to...

Phonics...

I can sound out most unfamiliar words accurately, without undue hesitation.
GPC: Short for Grapheme Phoneme Correspondence. Knowing a GPC means being able to match a phoneme (sound) to a grapheme (written representation) and vice versa.

Word reading...

I can read accurately most words of two or more syllables.
I can read more words containing common suffixes.
I can read most common exception words.
I can read words accurately and fluently without overtly sounding and blending them e.g. at over 90 words per minute.

Text reading...

I can check a familiar text, which I can read accurately and fluently, makes sense to me.

Listening & Discussing...

I can answer questions based on what is being said, and done, in a familiar text.
I can make some inferences based on what is being said, and done, in a familiar text.
