Dear Parents and Carers,

I cannot believe it's October already; this term is flying by! Here are some key messages for you this week:

#### **Parent Vote!**

We are considering a change to our PE policy and would like to get your opinion to help us make a decision. The change would include children coming into school wearing their PE kits on their PE days. Some benefits would be that it would:

- Raise the profile of PE in school to put more clearly in children's minds the importance of sport in leading active, healthy lives;
- Increase the amount of time for physical activity by cutting out time spent on changing
- Decrease lost property children would not need to bring a PE bag in with them
- Support children who are self-conscious changing in front of their peers

#### **Stomach bugs**

If your child has an upset tummy or is sick, please keep them at home for 48 hours after symptoms have stopped. Stomach bugs are highly contagious and it is unfair on children and staff if parents/carers send their child to school when they are poorly.

#### Parental involvement in sport

The NSPCC's Child Protection in Sport Unit (CPSU) have a new campaign running this week to ask parents to get involved in their children's sport, to be supportive and to help keep children safe. To support this, there is a new film called "My No.1 Fan", which features real families talking about what positive parental behaviour and support means to them and how negative behaviour can impact children's enjoyment of sport.





We are now offering support to over 600 people a week, can we help you too?





# Studybugs



## Why use Studybugs?

**Helps safeguard your child** by automating schools' processing of sick reports, so if any children are unaccounted for, they'll know right away. Also verifies that reports of your child's absence have really come from you.

**Contributes to public health** by collecting anonymised data on illnesses going around — to help schools, parents and public health organisations take preventative action as early as possible.

**Saves you time** — it takes seconds to give the school all they need, and know they've got the message even if you're reporting at 6am or 11pm the night before.

**Guides you** with official guidance from the UK Health Security Agency (formerly Public Health England) on the need to stay off school, based on the symptoms or illnesses you enter.


**Confidential and secure**. Your personal data is kept strictly confidential between you and your child's school. We never share your personal data with third parties. Your child's school cannot see your location. All shared illness data is first anonymised so your personal data is always kept confidential. You can also opt out of having your anonymised data shared. Studybugs is hosted from purpose-built secure facilities and all communications with our apps and website are encrypted.


# Young Minds Wear Yellow 10th October 2023

# Language Cafe




