Dear Parents and Carers,

#### **Over and above**

We have been thinking about all the extra things we do at Three Bridges to enhance learning and give the children as many cultural experiences as possible. This week Years 1, 2 and 5 went to the cinema to watch a film. There were some children who told me they had never been before. Next week the children will all watch this year's Pantomime as we know that this is often too expensive at local theatres. What else do you think we do over and above for the children? #### **Road Safety**

Please remind your child how to cross the road safely, especially if your child walks home alone. A concerned parent has reported a child almost ran into her car this week. The traffic island outside the upper site has limited space at the moment so please do take care if you are walking that way, Do use the traffic lights if possible to cross Gales Drive please.

#### **Termly Learning Conferences**

You should all have had your meeting with the class teacher by now. Thank you for coming to discuss your child's learning; I hope you found it helpful. I know that the children enjoy having this time with you and their class teacher. Can I remind parents and carers that if you need to discuss anything further with the class teacher, please make an appointment at the office. Teachers are incredibly busy both before and after school and cannot always meet immediately.

#### Late arrivals

As some of our children find it difficult to come into school first thing, we need to be able to close the gate on time, particularly on the lower site. It makes it difficult to let late arrivals in and out of the school grounds. Please be prompt and get your child to school before 8:55am!

We will be contacting those parents directly as we are concerned that some children may not be fed if food has not been ordered. Remember that you must book your child's Christmas Lunch as soon as possible otherwise they will be given a jacket potato.


