Maths Learning

We will be continuing with fractions, converting measures, exploring ratio, algebra and making links between fractions, decimals and percentages. We will also focus on area, perimeter and volume.

English Learning

In Spring I we will be basing our learning on our topic of Vikings. We will write our own versions of a Viking saga, based on Norse mythology, produce a blackout poem using Viking non-fiction, create some instructional writing and use writers' choice to write a story based on our text, Viking Boy.

In Spring 2, we will use some Viking-based experiences to inform our writing, creating a narrative and a report. We will also create a piece of persuasive writing,

Key Vocabulary: verse, skald, epistolary, dialogue.


Science Learning
