




Headteacher Awards



Greek pottery has four main types:
Geometric, Corinthian, Athenian Black-figure, and Athenian red-figure pottery. Pottery vessels were made for everyday use such as the two-handled amphora for storage, the single-stem kylix cup for drinking wine, and the three-handled hydra for holding water.

Greek pottery was often decorated with geometric designs or images from Greek mythology.




Cherry Class
