Dear Parents and Carers,

Please encourage your child to keep toys at home. It can be very upsetting for a child if they lose a precious toy in school. The school cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage of toys from home.






# **Headteacher Awards**

Here are some children who got a head teacher award today.





Bucket therapy was created by Gina Davies and is part of a four-stage "Attention Autism Activity". However, it works very well with all children within any setting and is very easy to implement.

Bucket therapy aims to support children's attention skills, helping them to develop and maintain focus for longer periods of time. With little preparation and just a few cheap props, the activity can be done anywhere.

The 'bucket' is a non-see-through container/bag, that holds a selection of small objects such as; wind-up, pop-up, musical or mechanical toys the children will find visually appealing, but which they have never seen before. Novelty value is key, so you need to build up a collection of lots of different items to maintain the element of surprise.


