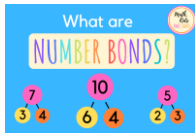

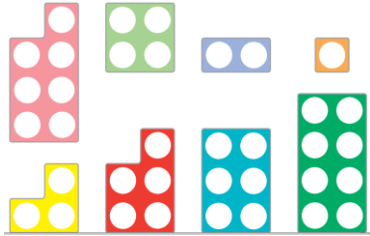

Support: Use the Numicon to make 10. How many different ways can you make 10?



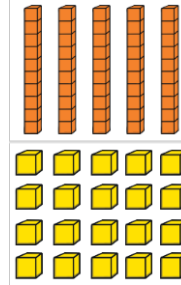
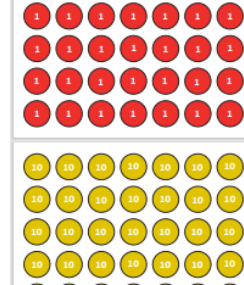
Place value
