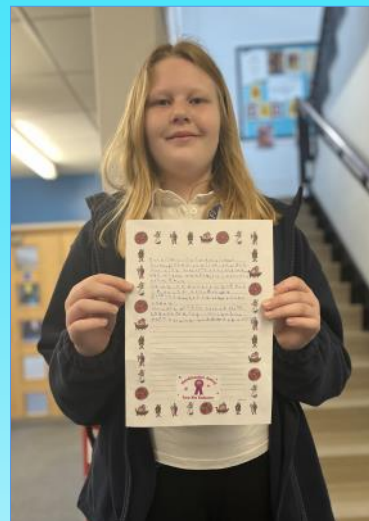
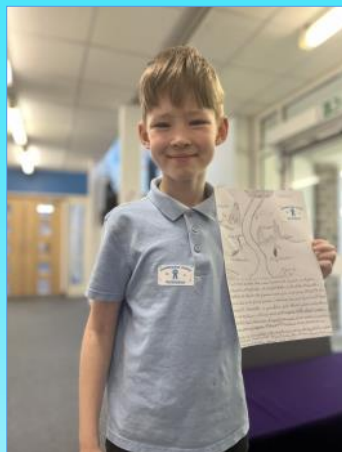

Rebecca Redfern (West Sussex Music) currently has a couple of spaces available for individual or group lessons.

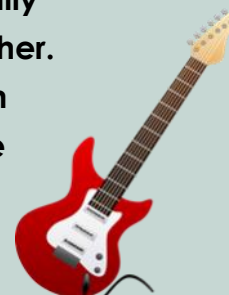
