

Maths

In Maths, we will be continuing to learn about mass and capacity. We will be exploring how to identify the intervals on a scale and find equivalent masses and volumes.

We will also be building on our understanding of fractions. We will be learning to add and subtract fractions and finding a fraction of an amount of objects.

After half term, we will be exploring how to tell the time to the nearest 5 minutes. We will be exploring adding and subtracting hours and minutes to a time.

We will also be learning about shape. We will be exploring different angles, compare them and learnt about parallel and perpendicular lines.

Science Learning

In Science this term, we will be learning about plants. We will be exploring the different parts of a plant and their functions. We will be learning about how plants transport water and how they reproduce.

Finally, we will be learning about how seeds are dispersed so new plants can grow. We will be identifying the different ways that they are dispersed.

PSHE

In PSHE, we will be learning about economic wellbeing. We will be learning about different methods of payment, how they work and when they are most appropriately used. After half term, we will be carrying out transition activities to prepare your child for their move into Year 4.

Computing - In computing, we will be exploring

RE - We will be exploring what the Bible is and why it is important for Christians. Then, we will be learning about the beliefs of Islam.

Music - We will be learning how to sing and perform a ballad. We will be writing our own chorus and our own verses and performing these in a group.

Key Vocabulary: ballad, chorus, verse, performance.
