# English

This term, we will start our Vikings and Anglo Saxons topic off by writing a setting description of Asgard and then we will be writing a story based on the Katherine Rundell story of Wolf Wilder. Following this, we will be writing two non-fiction pieces inspired by our real world experiences at Brownings Farm and the Railway Land Project. We will be writing a poem and a book review in the second half of the term.

#### Maths

In mathe we are continuing with our topic on fractions, decimals and percentages. Then we will be looking at perimeter and area of shapes. After that, we will be investigating statistics and different ways of interpreting and representing data.

## Science

In Science this term we will be learning about different materials and their properties! This will include looking at reversible and irreversible reactions and the three different states of matter. Later in the term we will look at the changes that occur in animals with a focus on humans.
