

### Maths Learning

In Autumn 1, will be focusing on place value up to 10,000,000, the four operations and learning various methods to solve problems.

In Autumn 2, pupils will be learning about fractions, how they can be simplified and solving problems with fractions using the four operations.

**Key Vocabulary:** operation, place value, addition, multiplication, division, subtraction.

### English Learning

In Autumn 1 we will be using knowledge learnt about the Tudor period to create exciting writing. We will be creating some nature-inspired poetry and writing a short story based on the book 'The Executioners Daughter'

In Autumn 2, we will be creating a diary based on the main character from the book, as well as reading and then retelling a classic Shakespeare play.

**Key Vocabulary:** soldier, gold sovereigns, Tudor, London, execution, play scripts, playwright, Shakespearean, language, archaic, amphitheatre, thatched

### Science Learning

Our science learning this term is living things. Over the topic we will be looking at what living things are, how animals and plants can be classified by identifying their features and looking at microorganisms.

**Key Vocabulary:** organism, classification, animals, plants, reptile, bird, amphibian, insect, mammal, fish, vascular, non-vascular.

## Tudors



### PSHE

In Autumn 1, pupils will be learning about respect - why it is important to respect others and challenging stereotypes. In Autumn 2, we will be learning about mindfulness, and how pupils can deal with change, resolving conflict and managing emotions.

**Key Vocabulary:** respect, stereotype, conflict, emotions

### PE

In PE we will be learning how to play Tag Rugby, as well as taking part in Team Building exercises. Ash Class are the first class in year 6 to take part in swimming lessons too.

**Key Vocabulary:** teamwork, tactics, try, kick, communication, strategy.

### Foundation Subjects

**Art:** We will be designing a Tudor rose, sketching our ideas before building the final piece out of clay.

**History:** Crime and Punishment. We will be exploring crime and punishment from the Roman period up to the Victorian era. Pupils will learn about how different groups have impacted crime and punishment over the past 2000 years.

**Key Vocabulary:** Romans, Anglo-Saxons, Vikings, Tudors, Victorians, crime, punishment, torture, execution.

**Music:** We will be learning about soundtracks in different types of media.

**Computing:** We will be learning about coding and how this is used in programming.

**Key Vocabulary:** coding, data, information, secret, password.

**RE:** Autumn 1 - Islam. Over the topic, pupils will learn about customs and traditions in Islam, including what a prophet is, prayer and stories from the Quran.

**Key Vocabulary:** Quran, prophet, prayer, paradise,

Autumn 2 - Humanism - this topic will introduce what Humanism is, what a worldview is, and explore the key ideas of humanism and notable thinkers views.
