Happy Friday everyone!

Winter has arrived, please make sure your child is dressed appropriately for school as we spend a lot of time outside regardless of the weather. I think the children are desperate to see some snow now!

Lost property

If your child has lost any clothes, do please check lost property as there are so many clothes to be claimed. If you could please check your child's name is on all of their clothes, including coats, shoes and PE kit, it would be a lot easier for us to return things to the correct child.

Picking up and dropping off your child

The lower site gates open at 8.25am and the upper site gates open at 8.35am. Children on the lower site should be collected at 3.10pm and the upper site children at 3.20pm. It is really important that your child is dropped off and collected on time. If a child arrives late persistently, this could be recorded as unauthorised absence and could result in a fixed penalty notice. If parents/carers are late to collect, your child may have to join After School Club on the upper site (charges could be incurred).

We do all have incredibly busy calendars and often there are meetings after school, which can mean that sometimes parents/carers may have to wait a couple of days for an appointment. 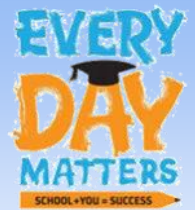

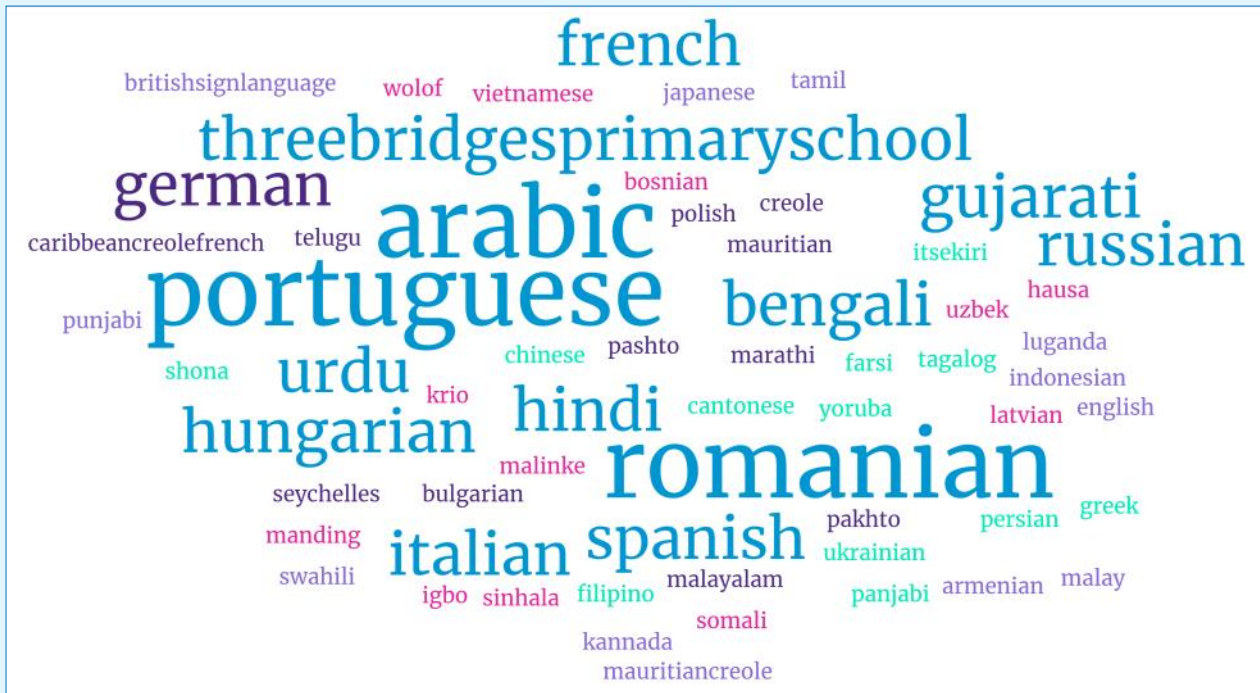
Languages Spoken at Three Bridges Primary School

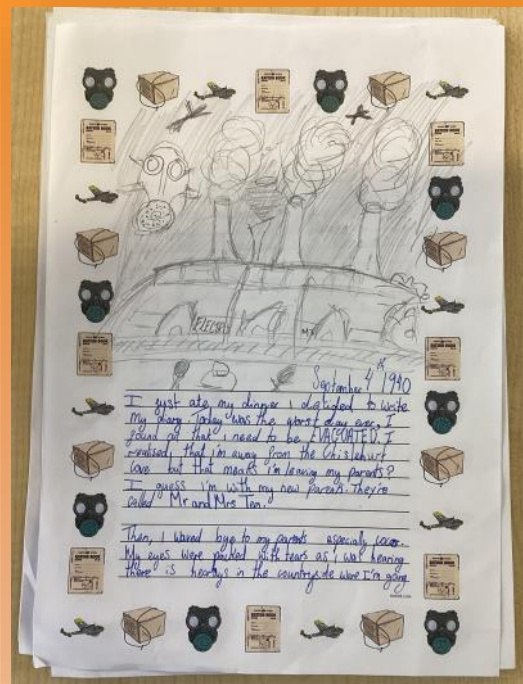
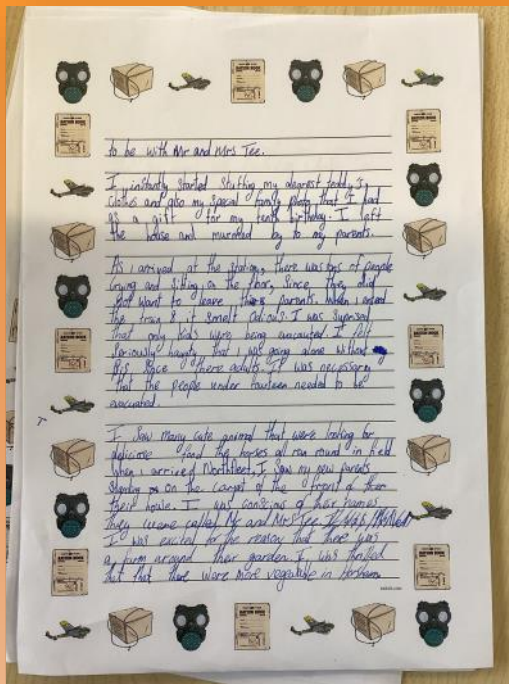
