

Maths

In Autumn 1, will be focusing on place value up to 10,000,000, the four operations and learning various methods to solve problems.

In Autumn 2, pupils will be learning about fractions, how they can be simplified and solving problems with fractions using the four operations.

Key Vocabulary: operation, place value, addition, multiplication, division, subtraction.

English

In Autumn 1 we will be focusing on grammar, punctuation, spelling and handwriting, giving pupils the necessary tools to create great pieces of writing.

In Autumn 2, we will begin by creating a recount of the PGL week, followed by a non-chronological report about outlaws, pirates and bandits. The final pieces of writing will be a letter and a setting description.

Key Vocabulary: nouns, verbs, adjectives, adverbs, recount, diary, non-chronological report, world war two

Science

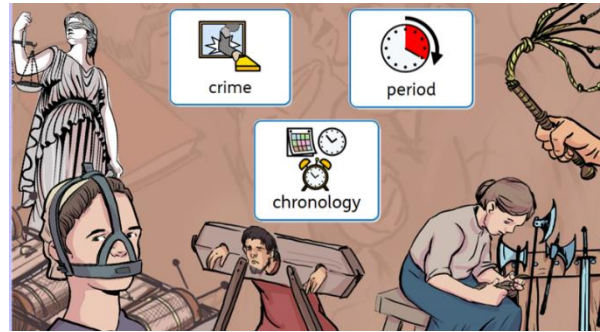
Our science learning in Autumn 1 will be about living things. Over the topic we will be looking at what living things are, how animals and plants can be classified by identifying their features. In Autumn 2, we will be learning about the circulatory system.

Key Vocabulary: organism, classification, animals, plants, reptile, bird, amphibian, insect, mammal, fish, vascular, non-vascular.

Crime and Punishment



PSHE

In Autumn 1, pupils will be learning about respect - why it is important to respect others and challenging stereotypes. In Autumn 2, we will be learning about mindfulness, and how pupils can deal with change, resolving conflict and managing emotions.

Key Vocabulary: respect, stereotype, conflict, emotions

PE

In PE we will be taking part in Team Building activities using a range of equipment. Ash Class are the first class in year 6 to take part in swimming lessons too.

Key Vocabulary: teamwork, tactics, support, communication, strategy.

Foundation Subjects

Art: Make my voice heard

This unit focuses on developing skills in using different art styles, exploring effects with tools, understanding and applying chiaroscuro and creating symbolic and expressive drawings. Pupils will form their own opinions about art, understand the impact of techniques and convey messages through their artwork.

Key Vocabulary: chiaroscuro, graffiti, mark making, impact, audience, charcoal, emotion, imagination

History: We will be exploring crime and punishment from the Roman period up to the Victorian era. Pupils will learn about how different groups have impacted crime and punishment over the past 2000 years.

Key Vocabulary: Romans, Anglo-Saxons, Vikings, Tudors, Victorians, crime, punishment, torture, execution.

Music: We will be learning about soundtracks in different types of media.

Computing: We will be learning about using Python commands.

Key Vocabulary: command, Logo, nested loops, Python.

RE: Autumn 1 - Islam. Over the topic, pupils will learn about customs and traditions in Islam, including what a prophet is, prayer and stories from the Qur'an.

Key Vocabulary: sacred, idol, Mecca, prophet, guidance, Madrasah

Autumn 2 - Expressing faith through the arts. We will be looking at how art and music is used to express religious feelings.

Key Vocabulary: express, faith, emotion, symbol, scripture.
