Creative learning

Read Daily:

Write a letter to an author:

- Who your favourite character was.
- What your favourite part was.
- Would you like them to write another one?

Visit the library:

Visit your local library and read a book. If you are signed up, you can take books home to read!

You might want to read:

- A book about The Stone Age
- A story book
- A nonfiction book about your favourite topic.

Topic

Art/DT

The Stone Age humans would draw about the world around them and things that happen in their lives, for example, hunting for animals. Create a cave painting showing what you do in your life.

OR

Use natural materials you can find outdoors to create your own Stone Age shelters.

How do we know about early history? Archaeologists are scientists who learn about the past by digging up artefact and discovering buried buildings.



Bury items discovered from The Stone Age. You can use sand to go on an actual dig. What were these items used for? Present your findings in a chosen way.
