

Your child is in **Yellow Group**.

In this group, they will continue to learn to read Set 3 sounds:



The children learn three sounds a week and review them on a Thursday and Friday. They will learn to read words containing the set 3 sounds and including longer words on the review days.

“Special friends, Fred talk, read the word”



“p-l-ea-se please!”



Children will continue to learn to read the set 1, set 2 and previously taught set 3 words speedily.

They will also continue to read alien words (nonsense words)...



...and spell using Fred Fingers- focussing on set 2 and 3 words.



Your child will be ready for the next group (Blue) when they can: Read the first six Set 3 sounds (ea, oi, a-e, i-e, o-e, u-e) speedily. Read these sounds in real and nonsense words.

Read a passage at 60-70 words per minute attempting a story telling voice and showing some understanding of what they have read.

How can you help at home? Give your child time to practise reading the yellow book bag book that is sent home weekly.



Aim for your child to read an assigned storybook on the Oxford Owl website each week. They will need to read the same book three times in a week to increase their speed of reading each time.
