## **PUPIL ACCEPTABLE USE POLICY AGREEMENT FOR YOUNGER PUPILS (EYFS/KS1)**

For younger children (EYFS and KS1) - the school will ensure that this policy is discussed fully with pupils and that they will receive online safety education to help them understand the importance of safe use of technology and the internet – both in and out of school.

This is how we stay safe when we use computers:

- I will ask a teacher or suitable adult if I want to use the computers/tablets
- I will only use activities that a teacher or suitable adult has told or allowed me to use
- I will take care of the computer and other equipment
- I will ask for help from a teacher or suitable adult if I am not sure what to do or if I think I have done something wrong
- I will tell a teacher or suitable adult if I see something that upsets me on the screen
- I know that if I break the rules I might not be allowed to use a computer/tablet

Three Bridges Primary School has also adopted for use the Parent/Carer Acceptable Use Agreement as this provides additional permission forms (including the digital and video images permission form) and will require the signature of the parent/carer to confirm agreement of the policy on behalf of their child.

***Pupils will be required to sign the Acceptable Use Policy Agreement for Older Pupils (KS2) when they move into Year 3 of Three Bridges Primary school.***
