











Home learning grid - Summer Term - The Romans

<p>Fact page Can you find out more about the Roman Empire? Create a fact page about one of the key elements of the Empire, for example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- The Roman Army- Important emperors- Romulus and Remus- Gladiators 	<p>Diary Entry In English, we are going to write diary entries from the point of view of a Roman slave. Practise writing a diary about your own life. Include the most important things that happened to you each day and explain what you were thinking. Can you keep it up for a whole week?</p> 	<p>Rome Rome was the capital of the Roman Empire. Can you find any important landmarks in Rome and sketch them?</p> 
<p>Museum trip! Visit a museum that specialises in History! Explore the different artefacts they store. Can you find any connected to the Romans. Crawley Museum is close by and free for entry!</p> 	<p>Poetry Can you explore writing poetry at home? Try writing an acrostic poem, a haiku or even a rhyming poem. We'd love to read some poems out during story time!</p>	<p>Collages We are going to look at collages and exploring how we can 'draw' with scissors.
