

Maths

In Maths, we will be learning about mass and capacity, we will be exploring how to measure the mass of objects using scales. We will also be learning how to read scales going up in intervals of hundreds.

In the next unit of fractions we will be learning how to add and subtract fractions and finding fractions of objects and amounts.

Later in the term, we will be learning about money.. We will be able to recognise coins and notes, convert pounds and pence and find change.

After that, we will be learning how to tell the time to the nearest minute. Then we will be learning about shape and identifying turns and angles and recognising and describing 2D and 3D shapes.

Science Learning

In Science this term, we will be learning about animals and humans, we will be looking at the bones that make up the skeleton and what our muscles do. We will be carrying out an investigation to see if the length of our bones affects the distance that we can jump.

After that we will be learning about plants, we will be learning about the different parts of a plant and their functions. We will be learning about what plants need to survive.

PSHE

In PSHE, we will be learning about citizenship and how we can take care of the environment around us.

We will be learning about recycling and who is responsible for recycling and keeping the environment tidy. We will also be looking into the groups of people that make up a community.

English Learning

In English, we will start the term off by writing a biography about an evil villain. We will also be writing a narrative using the evil villain that we create. In the summer term we will then complete a persuasive advert and a non-chronological report, both about honeybees!

Writing focus

- Using commas for a list
- Use of subordinating conjunctions to express time and place
- Apostrophes to mark possessions

Foundation Learning

Geography - We will be looking at the countries that make up the United Kingdom. We will be focusing on the human and physical features of the United Kingdom. We will learn how to use compasses, symbols and keys to read a map.

Key Vocabulary: England, Wales, Scotland, Northern Ireland, compass, Landmark, key

Art - We will be creating a Monoprinting of a bee hive, using stencils and paint.

Key Vocabulary: pattern, shape, abstract, paint, colour.

DT - We will be planning and making a seasonal fruit tart. We will be exploring where different foods come from around the world and learn how to safely cut and prepare fruits and vegetables.

Key Vocabulary: design, fruit, seasonal, temperate, taste.

Computing - In computing, we will be exploring a programming app called Scratch. We will be looking at how to work a programme and how to set instructions through an application and create an animation.

Key Vocabulary: algorithm, animation, code, debug.

French - Learning about the months

RE - We will be learning about Islam

Key Vocabulary: Five Pillars, pilgrimage, monotheism

Music - we will be learning about ballads and creating our own ballads using a video for inspiration.

Key Vocabulary: ballad, chorus verse, unison, composition
