

SCHOOL UNIFORM

All children are asked to wear the school uniform, which is available from Tesco by logging on to www.tesco.com/ues.

The following items are recommended:

BOYS

- Grey trousers or grey shorts in summer
- Navy blue sweatshirt or fleece with school crest (available from the Tesco website above)
- Pale blue or white polo shirt or shirt (polo shirt with school crest is available from the Tesco website above)
- Black shoes

GIRLS

- Grey pinafore, skirt or trousers
- Pale blue or white polo shirt or blouse (polo shirt with school crest is available from the Tesco website above)
- Blue checked dresses or grey shorts in summer
- Navy blue sweatshirt, cardigan or fleece with school crest (available from the Tesco website above)
- Plain white, black, navy or grey socks or tights
- Black shoes

Please ensure that your child has a smart, comfortable pair of shoes to wear with their uniform.

P.E. KIT

- White t-shirt (T-shirt with school crest is available from the Tesco website above)
- Navy blue shorts
- Black 'slip on' plimsolls for children in EYFS & Yr. 1 and trainers for all other children.
- A separate sweatshirt or tracksuit for cold weather (navy blue).

A drawstring bag (available from the Tesco website if required) is strongly recommended to keep your child's P.E kit tidy.

Outdoor Clothing

Additionally, all children will require waterproof coats (and trousers in EYFS and KS1) as well as Wellington Boots as they will have access to the outdoor area/playtime outside whatever the weather (unless it is considered to be unsafe to do so).

All clothing should be clearly marked with your child's name to enable us to return lost items to their owners. If your child loses an item of clothing they should first check either the lost property cupboard located in the Lower Site reception area, or one of the large 'bins' situated in the cloakrooms at the Upper Site. Please feel free to come into school, at the beginning or end of the school day, to assist your child in locating their lost property.

Jewellery

Stud earrings and watches are permitted, no other jewellery is allowed. Exceptions are allowed due to religious observance. If your child is wearing earrings on a day on which she/he has a sporting activity, the child will be asked to remove them. Therefore, parents are asked not to send their child to school wearing earrings when they have PE or a sporting event at/after school. We would also suggest that if your child wishes to have their ears pierced that this is done at the beginning of the long summer holidays.

We do not allow make-up or nail varnish to be worn.

School Bags

All children in EYFS and KS1 require a book bag and children in KS2 require a drawstring bag or back pack – to be brought to school daily (these are available from the Tesco website).

Non-School Uniform Days

The school organises 'non-school uniform' days throughout the school year (parents will be advised of the dressing up theme if applicable in advance). Although children are permitted to wear their own clothing we ask parents to ensure that their child does not wear high heels or strappy shoes that are not suitable for keeping them safe around the school site (climbing stairs, using climbing frames, etc.); their normal school shoes should be worn.
