What will the music tell us about the event?</li> <li>2. What setting would you use? How will this help what's happening in the story? What's the most expensive lunch you can have and what's the cheapest?</p>	<p>Write a letter to a friend about your experiences as a child living in Pompeii during the eruption of Mount Vesuvius.</p> <p>Remember to say why you are writing and who your letter is from. Make your letter exciting by using adjectives.</p> <p>Example: I felt terrified! My body froze as I watched...</p>	<p>Reading Challenge!</p> <p>How many chapter books can you read from cover to cover up until Christmas? Make sure you keep a record of the book you're reading, the date that you started and finished, as well as a brief review about your book.</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  </div> <p>You can record this in the back of your homework book.</p>
<p>Keep a schedule of your daily routine. Make a note of what you've done at what time and present it in the form of a table.</p>	<p>Can you think of 5 questions you would like to ask a person who lived in the town of Pompeii? Remember to ask questions that will not give a yes or no answer. Example What happened to your..... when the.....? Why?</p>	
<p><b>Topic/History/Geography</b></p> <p>Create a fun fact file based around our Volcano topic. Can you remember: How a volcano is formed? What the three types of volcano are? What a volcano is?
